Food Safety Modernization: Facility Re-registration

The Food Safety Modernization Act of 2011', requires facilities that manufacture, process, pack or hold food within the United States or foreign food facilities that export to the United States to re-register their facility with the FDA every even numbered year between October 1st and December 31st. Compliance with these regulations is mandatory as of 2012. Registrants are required to submit registration to FDA containing the new information added by section 102 of FSMA; failure to register may result in FDA mandated plant closures as per Section 102*. All entities who supply, store, or broker ingredients or finished products must re-register and be aware of the Prior Notice of Imported Foods.
